- **Academic OneFile** - Contains one of the largest collections of peer reviewed journals with an extensive coverage of full text articles. Selective full text articles come from magazines, newspapers, and broadcast transcripts as well as podcasts, video files, and RSS feeds are included. Covers subjects from the arts, business, computers, education, humanities, literature, medicine, philosophy, science, social sciences, technology and other discipline.
- **ProQuest** - Serves as the central resource for researchers at all levels in all markets with journals, magazines, newspapers as well as RSS feed. Covers 160 academic disciplines. Considered the largest aggregated full-text database in the market today.
- **Credo Reference** - Provides access to a selection of reference books, including encyclopedias and dictionaries. It also includes cross-references to other resources provided by the Library, such as: Ebrary, the PGCC online catalog, and research databases.
